



Minutes: Membership Meeting April 19, 2026

- I. **Officers Present**
 - a. President Don Kile, Vice President Tom Burrows, Treasurer Joe Zapach, Financial Secretary Elizabeth Hons, Activities Coordinator Kristin McMaster.
 - b. There were approximately 25 members present for the meeting.
- II. **Pledge of allegiance**
 - a. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited by members.
- III. **Reading of previous meeting's minutes**
 - a. Don noted that the previous month's minutes were available on the website and emailed to members. No questions.
- IV. **Presentation of the monthly financial statement**
 - a. Don shared the financial statement. The report was accepted by membership.
