



Minutes: Membership Meeting August 16, 2026

- I. **Officers Present**
 - a. Meeting was called to order at 2:00 pm by Don Kile.
 - b. President Don Kile, Vice President Tom Burrows, Treasurer Joe Zapach, Recording Secretary Karen Klingler, Communications coordinator Ralph Stola, Activities Coordinator Kristin McMaster.
 - c. There were 33 members present at the meeting.
- II. **Pledge of allegiance**
 - a. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited by members.
- III. **Reading of previous meeting's minutes**
 - a. Last month's minutes were read by Karen and accepted by membership. No questions.
- IV. **Presentation of the monthly financial statement**
 - a. Don/Joe shared the financial statement. The report was accepted by membership.
- V. **Report of Committees:**
 - a. In the interest of getting youth out to the club, Kristin did some research on the topic:
 - i. Young people need a purpose to come
 - ii. Jr. competitive leagues, fun shoots and fishing
 - iii. Young leaders – brainstorm together on
 1. Gun safety, situational awareness, etc
 2. Perhaps form a youth club with its own logo etc.
 - iv. Do outreach to local veterans – match up young folks with them
 - v. Have the youth handle their own social media about their activities
 - vi. Ralph could make room on the website for them
 - vii. Perhaps the young group can attend hunter safety together (at Weston fire co.?)
- VI. **Old Business**
 - a. The metal roof is painted/sealed thanks to John.
 - b. Carl Kak mentioned a tree leaning over the wires at the last meeting. Karen contacted Dave Irvin out of Eagle Rock who has not set a date to visit. John M. and Carl Kak are solving the leaning tree problem in the back of the clubhouse.
 - c. Carl Kuchler noted that most of the shirts that were ordered have been picked up. Only the Hons' remain.
 - d. Special topic: remediation plan for beetles eating the clubhouse.
 - i. Last month we discussed option for getting a vendor to do this work or allowing John to complete the application of the Tim-bor. We tabled a decision to this meeting.
 - ii. Since then, John with Bud Dick have installed a ventilation fan and humidifier (donated by Bud) in the basement. The next step is to install plastic sheeting and p gravel to complete the floor covering to mitigate moisture entry. Dean Nardon is pricing p gravel for the club.
 - iii. John has finished the Tim-bor application in the basement and has seen positive results. He continued to apply it to the attic where the fungus is also a problem due to moisture. He has requested, since he just moved on forward, to be able to complete the job with the main floor. He needs only one more can of Tim-bor. Since he is 2/3 complete the membership approved the purchase and John's continued remediation.
- VII. **New Business**
 - a. Dean Nardon has some new walking targets for the pistol range.
 - b. Larry Dobash has cleared the little pavilion and will refurbish it with drainage and posts and pressure treated lumber. His request for ~\$500 was approved.
 - c. Larry D also noted that our trees are being overtaken by the 'mile a minute' weed which will kill all of the trees and brush if allowed to grow uncontrolled. He has done research and identified a bug that eats this weed. The bugs cost \$1 each. He would like permission to purchase 500 when they are available. This was approved by membership. Geoff offered to assist because NJ sells this at a discount to NJ residents.
 - d. There was an interest raised for Starlink again. Geoff offered to check into current pricing and availability for our assessment.
